Basic Rigging (1 day)

This 8 hour Basic Rigging Training covers the fundamental knowledge and principles in the care, use, maintenance, inspection and limitations of slings and rigging for novice/beginner crane operators or riggers. It is a theory based program to introduce the Alberta Occupational Health & Safety Act, Regulation, and Code and helps to reinforce the importance of training and safety when working around this equipment. The course also includes Basic Rigging hitches and pre-use inspection. Upon completion of this course, attendees will have a basic understanding of Rigging. The attendees will be required to pass a written exam (80%). *There are no pre-requisites for this course.*

“MAKING YOUR MOVE” THE SAFE USE OF OVERHEAD CRANES (1 DAY)

“Making Your Move” the Safe Use of Overhead Cranes (1 day)

This 8 hour “Making Your Move” course is a beginners hand’s on training course that incorporates Basic Rigging and crane operation and simple lift planning for personnel to orientate themselves with hazards associated with crane and rigging use. It is a simple yet effective introduction to the safe use of overhead cranes, rigging and legislative requirements (video presented program). Upon completion of this course, attendees will be trained in the safe and most efficient methods of overhead crane operations. The attendees will be required to pass a written exam (80%). *There are no pre-requisites for this course.*

Overhead Crane “Train the Trainer” (3 day)

This 3 day program is intended to help start a company on the road to a training program designed to instruct personnel on the safe use of overhead cranes and rigging. Day 1 training refreshes the participant on OHS Legislation and introduce CSA and ASME standards. On day 2 the participant will be required to go through theory based instruction and information gathering, giving tips and ideas that may be required for additional content to help in personalizing (creating a site specific) training program. The 3rd day will be practical participation where the participant will be required to deliver a 15 minute segment of the “Making Your Move” Training content, and then participate in crane operation and course completion. Upon completion of this course, attendees will be able to effectively train their company Crane Operators in the safe and most efficient methods of overhead crane operation. The attendees will be required to pass a written exam (80%) and practical. *Pre-requisites for this course are a minimum 1 year rigging and crane experience or other circumstances deemed appropriate by MHSA. Attendees must submit a letter from their employer (signed by management) confirming the experience of the attendee. Accompanying the letter should be any applicable copies of certificates or any other relevant documents.*

Overhead Crane "Train the Trainer" Refresher (1 day)

This 8 hour course combines Basic Rigging and Train the Trainer practical based training. This program is designed to refresh the participant on the current Alberta Occupational Health & Safety Act, Regulation and Code and the CSA and ASME Standards. During this training session, the participant will be involved in practical participation requiring a delivery of a 15 minute segment of the "Making Your Move" Training content, then participate in crane operation and course completion. Upon completion of this course attendees will be re-certified as a Crane "Train the Trainer. The attendees will be required to pass a written exam (80%) and practical. *Course attendees must have an existing Basic Rigging certification and Crane "Train the Trainer" certification. The Overhead Crane "Train the Trainer" Refresher is required every 3 years.*

MHSA Crane and Rigging Evaluation

The Evaluation Tool will involve reviewing the following:

- Hazard Assessments
- Inspections
- Safe Work Practices
- PPE
- Lift Plans
- Rigging and Overhead Crane Training
- Log Books
- Legislative Compliance

Site specific activity, documentation and in houses practices will also be evaluated.

Benefits of conducting an Evaluation are to verify compliance of your Crane and Rigging program to the current Standards. **Once completed the Evaluation Tool will be discussed in detail, outlining strengths and opportunity for improvement.**
