- WCB claim management
- Works closely with Management team and supervisors regarding the development of site specific safe work practices, procedures and hazard assessments.
- Conduct and participate in safety meetings
- Recommends changes to improve the safety programs
- Conduct training on all respects of MHTA and/or ACSA COR programs
- Completing COR certification and maintenance audits, reviewing findings and work toward implementing changes
- Participate in safety auditing
- Provides site specific orientation to seasonal workers and/or visitors new to the worksite/crews
- Travel to different sites across the city and out of town for OHS coverage
- Other duties as required

Qualifications:

- Completed MHTA and/or ACSA safety officer certification program or equivalent
- Some experience in safety coordination in a construction company (preferably road construction) and camp environment
- Previous experience implementing safety programs will be an asset
- Previous experience working with different stakeholders in the field and camps
- Strong skills in Microsoft Office (Word, Excel)
- Ability to take initiative, think logically and complete detailed work with a high degree of accuracy and confidentiality;
- Excellent written and oral communication skills along with the ability to be flexible to changing priorities;
- Possession of a valid class 5 driver's license or above and a clean driver's abstract will be required;
- Ability to work collaboratively in a team and independently with little supervision.

Other requirements:

- Ability to work long hours sometimes including weekends, overtime as required
- Travel to offsite locations occasionally is required
- Safety equipment will be required to be worn while onsite (Steel toed safety boots, safety glasses/goggles, etc.)
- Offsite work can be in an outdoor setting, which could include inclement weather, heat and humidity, and exposure to dust and asphalt
- Hazards associated with constructions sites may be present
